NOTICE OF RACE (Amended 14 February 2010)

1	RULES
1.1*	The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 -2012</i> .
1.2	The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply
1.3	The Paper Tiger Class rules will apply.
1.4	For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
2	ADVERTISING Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
3*	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
3.1	The regatta is open to Australian and New Zealand Teams of the Paper Tiger Class by Invitation from their respective class association.
3.2	Eligible boats may enter by: Completing the attached entry form and sending it, together with the required fee of \$NZ 210 to: Napier PT Squad, c/o Stuart Morrish, 12 Petane Rd, Napier, 4104 by 1700hrs on Friday the <u>26th</u> February 2010, or by emailing it to, stuandkaren@xtra.co.nz and depositing the required entry fee into the Napier PT Squad Account 03 1753 0481130 00 by 1700hrs on Friday the 19 th February 2010. Reference Boat Number to match payment. E.g. "PT776"
3.3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Late entries accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$NZ 50 will be accepted up until 1500 hrs on the 1st April 2010
3.4	To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority and be a member of their National Paper Tiger Class Association.
3.5	The <u>Internationals Teams Trophy</u> will be contested between teams complying with clause 3.1. Each team will be made up of 10 sailors that must be named/confirmed prior to close of registration on the 1 st of April 2010.



4	<p>FEES</p> <p>Required fees are as follows:</p> <p><i>Entry fee</i> \$NZ 210 (<i>Excludes regatta shirt</i>)</p> <p><i>Shirts</i> \$NZ 45.00</p> <p><i>Entry fee + Late entry fee</i> \$NZ 260 (<i>excludes regatta shirt</i>)</p>
5	SCHEDULE
5.1*	<p>Registration:</p> <p>Thursday, 1st April 2010, from 0900 hrs to 1500 hrs at Napier Sailing Club</p>
5.2	<p>Measurement and inspection:</p> <p>Thursday, 1st April 2010, from 0900 hrs to 1500 hrs at Napier Sailing Club</p>
5.3	<p>Briefing:</p> <p>Thursday, 1st April 2010, at 1700 hrs at Napier Sailing Club</p>
5.4	The scheduled time of the warning signal for race 1 is 10:55 hrs on Friday the 2 nd of April 2010.
5.5	3 races are scheduled per day. A total of 8 races are scheduled.
5.6	No race shall start after <u>1330</u> hrs on Monday 5 th April 2010.
6	<p>MEASUREMENTS</p> <p>Boats must be presented for measurement and equipment identification marking, in accordance with clause 5.2</p>
7	<p>SAILING INSTRUCTIONS</p> <p>The sailing instructions will be available at the completion of measurement and registration.</p>
8	<p>VENUE</p> <p>Racing will be held on the waters of Hawke Bay</p>
9	<p>THE COURSES</p> <p>The courses to be sailed will be a combination of triangle, windward/leeward courses, <u>with a priority on Triangle, Windward/Leeward, Triangle.</u></p>
10	<p>PENALTY SYSTEM</p> <p>Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.</p>
11	SCORING
11.1	5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
11.2	When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.



11.3	The International Teams Trophy will be scored separately using only those sailors identified in clause 3.5
12	SUPPORT BOATS Team support boats must be registered with the organising authority at registration (clause 5.1 above)
13	LAUNCHING Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Napier Sailing Club
14	RADIO COMMUNICATION Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
15	PRIZES Prizes will be given as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall using all entries • 1st Junior (<u>under 18</u> on the 1 April 2010), using all entries • Winning Team (Clauses 3.5 & 11.3)
16	INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with valid Racing Insurance (minimum cover \$NZ 20,000 or equivalent) and third-party liability insurance (minimum cover of NZ\$500,000 or the equivalent.)
17	DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

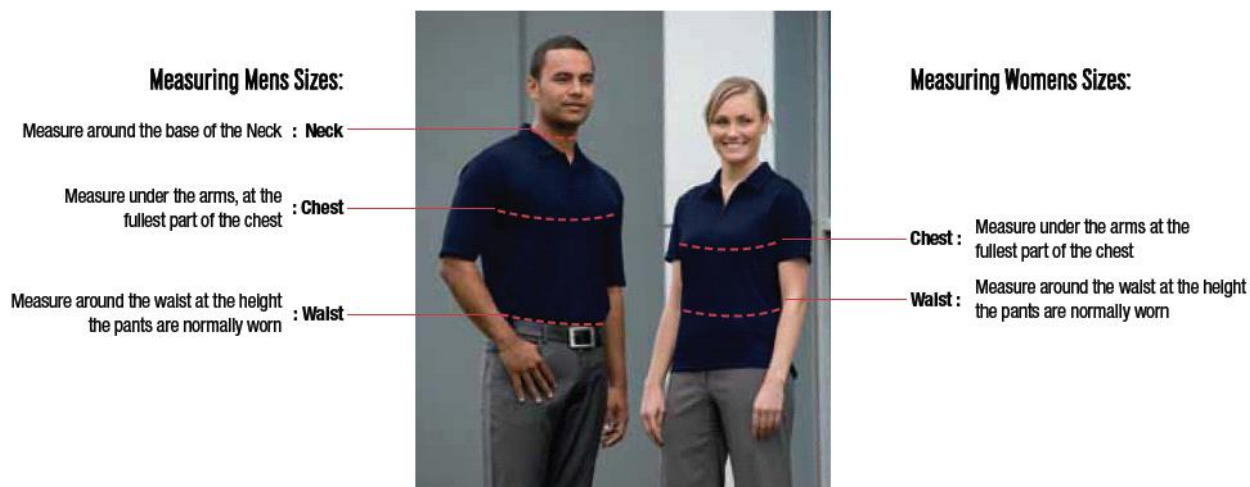
